# Required documents for nationals;

Russia, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgiz, Moldova, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, Uzbekistan

with temporary resident visa **(student)** of Australia to apply for the following visa to Japan

Temporary Visitor> (Holiday, Visiting Friends/Relatives, Business, Attending a conference)

The following must be submitted with the application for this visa:

- 1. A valid passport with a valid Australian visa
- 2. Two completed visa application forms
- 3. Two recent (taken within 6 months) passport photographs (Australian standard size passport photo)
- 4. Flight itinerary (If you are traveling through another country before you visit Japan, a full flight itinerary is required starting from Australia, not only the flight itinerary to and from Japan).
- 5. An official letter is required from the applicant's school or university confirming his/her enrolment (This letter must be current and we do not accept CoE for this purpose)
  - <u>Please note:</u> This enrolment letter must include a date, signature and be printed on the school/university's letter head
- 6. Copy of the applicant's full bank statement for the last 3 months with a current balance (the current balance must show sufficient funds for the trip to Japan)
- 7. The documents listed below must be provided by your guarantor, relative or friend in Japan.
  - A) A letter of guarantee (Mimoto Hoshosho)
  - **B)** A letter of reason for invitation from your relative or friend living in Japan. (**Shohei Riyusho**)
  - **C)** An itinerary for your stay (**Taizai yoteihyo**)
  - **D)** Documents verifying the relationship between the visa applicant and the person inviting (such as letters, photographs, etc.)

### E) ①If your guarantor is a Japanese national

- A current Residential Certificate (Jyu-min hyo)
- An Employment Certificate (Zaishoku shomei) issued by the company, if the guarantor is a company employee

A Company's Registration **(Hojin tokibo tohon)** issued by the Legal Affairs Bureau, if the guarantor is a company director

A copy of Business Permission Certificate (Eigyo kyoka sho), if the

### 2 If your guarantor is NOT a Japanese national

- A current Residential Certificate (Jyu-min hyo)
- An Employment Certificate (Zaishoku shomei) issued by the company, if the guarantor is a company employee or

A Company's Registration **(Hojin tokibo tohon)** issued by the Legal Affairs Bureau, if the guarantor is a company director or

A copy of Business Permission Certificate (Eigyo kyoka sho), if the guarantor is self-employed

- **F)** Guarantor's Tax Certificate (**Nozei shomeisho**) <u>showing annual income</u> issued by the Mayor'soffice, the head of the Ward's office, or taxation office in Japan.
- **G)** Documents from the person inviting the visa applicant (only if the person inviting is different from the guarantor).
- A Current Residential Certificate (**Jyu-min hyo**)
- An Employment Certificate (Zaishoku shomei) or An Enrolment Certificate (Zaigaku shomei)

### **IMPORTANT**

- ★ Additional documents may be requested if necessary.
- ★ If you are planning to continue your journey to another foreign country following Japan, the applicant must have the appropriate visa for that country before applying for the Japanese visa.
- ★ Visa applications must be referred to Japan and it generally takes up to 2 months to process.
- ★ Visa fees vary. Please enquire to the Visa section.
- ★ When requesting the return of passports by mail, please bring a SELF-ADDRESSED PREPAID **Registered Post** envelope (available from Australia Post) and please allow extra time for the mail delay.

The following must be submitted with the application for this visa:

- 1. A valid passport with a valid Australian visa
- 2. Two completed visa application forms
- 3. Two recent (taken within 6 months) passport photographs (Australian standard size passport photo)
- 4. Flight itinerary (full flight details from an accredited travel agent or airline)
- 5. A letter is required from the applicant's school or university confirming his/her enrolment
- 6. A visa for the next country you will visit after Japan
- 7. Proof of an accommodation arrangement or copies of the applicant's full bank statement for the last 3 months with a current balance
  - ★ Additional documents may be requested if necessary
  - ★ Processing time is a minimum of 3 working days.
  - ★ Visa fees vary. Please enquire to the Visa section.
  - ★ When requesting the return of passports by mail, please bring a SELF-ADDRESSED PREPAID Registered Post envelope (available from Australia Post) and please allow extra time for the mail delay.
