As the year begins to wind down, things have been ramping up at the Consulate with a variety of exciting visits and events happening across Queensland, particularly in sporting and education.

Athletes from Japan touched down in Brisbane for the Virtus Oceania Asia Games 2022. Consul-General ONO was excited to cheer them on and celebrate diversity through sport as he attended the men's basketball finals between Japan and Australia. The Consul-General also attended the 2022 Gold Coast Budo Challenge, presented by Kyokushin Karate Gold Coast Inc. It is fantastic to see the return of world class sporting events after a tough couple of years.

We are also beginning to see the return of student programs, including the Japan Agricultural Exchange Council program, which has brought 11 Japanese agricultural trainees to live and work on local farms in Bowen. The Consulate was also pleased to support the 2022 Iwasaki Sangyo Prize, which is provided by the Queensland Department of Education International to give Year 12 students the opportunity to undertake a 4-week immersion program in Japan.
