- 1. Before entering the Consulate-General, please sanitise your hands with sanitiser provided upon entry. Your temperature will also be checked prior to entry (contactless), and should your temperature read higher than 37.5 degrees Celsius, you will not be permitted to enter our office.
- 2. Although the Queensland State Government has eased the mandatory mask requirement as of 6:00pm, March 4th 2022 (Friday), the Consulate-General recommends mask wearing inside our office for your own safety.
- 3. The maximum number of people who may enter the waiting room at one time is seven (excluding families). Should there be eight or more wishing to enter the waiting room at one time, your contact details will be taken down and we kindly request that you wait outside of the Consulate office until you are contacted to enter.
