

Notice of Changes to Entry Requirements from Thursday 11 November

Consulate-General of Japan, Brisbane

From Thursday, 11 November 2021, the Queensland State Government announced the easing of mask requirements for the 11 local government areas of South East Queensland including Brisbane once 80% of Queenslanders have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine.

The entry requirements of the Consulate-General of Japan in Brisbane have also changed accordingly as per below.

1. Before entering the Consulate-General, please wash your hands and sanitise your hands with sanitiser provided upon entry. Your temperature will also be checked prior to entry (contactless), and should your temperature read higher than 37.5 degrees Celsius, you will not be permitted to enter our office.
2. The maximum number of people who may enter the waiting room at one time is seven (excluding families). Should there be eight or more wishing to enter the waiting room at one time, your contact details will be taken down and we kindly request that you wait outside of the Consulate office until you are contacted to enter.
