To Tonga, From the People of Japan

In the wake of the volcanic eruption in the Kingdom of Tonga, the Japan Air Self-Defense Force deployed C-130 transport aircraft to RAAF Base Amberley, Queensland to assist with the delivery of relief supplies to Tonga.

With the support of the Australian Defence Force, the C-130 transport aircraft airlifted drinking water, canned fish, pressure washers, and other items to Tonga. The Force returned to Japan on 9 February after completing their duties.

Consul-General Ono visited Amberley to see off the C-130s and Japanese Self-Defense Force personnel returning to Japan. There he took the opportunity to meet with Col. FUJII Hiroshi, Flight Group Commander, and exchange ideas.
