Entry Procedure for the Consulate-General From 15 April

Consulate-General of Japan, Brisbane

Effective as of 6:00am, 15 April (Thursday), the mask requirement rule will be revoked. Therefore, a mask will no longer be required to be worn inside the Consulate-General from this day. However, we apologise for any inconvenience caused and ask for your understanding and co-operation as the following restrictions will still continue to be in place.

1. Before entering the waiting room, please ensure that you wash your hands at the bathrooms located directly behind our main entrance. Please also use the hand sanitiser that is available in the security screening area.

Additionally, your temperature will be checked (contactless) at the security screening area and should your temperature read higher than 37.5 degrees Celsius, you will not be permitted to enter our office. Please also wear the face mask you carry upon entering the waiting room of our office.

 The maximum number of people who may enter the waiting room at one time is six (excluding families).
Should there be seven or more wishing to enter the waiting room at one time, you are kindly requested to wait outside of the Consulate office with your

contact details taken down until you will be contacted to enter.
