Multiple-entry Visa Requirements for Chinese Citizens with Substantial Income

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Chinese citizens with sufficient financial capability/substantially high income
- 2. Visa applications are accepted <u>only from residents in Queensland</u> Please refer to the following website to check the area of jurisdiction http://www.brisbane.au.emb-japan.go.jp/en/visa/index.html
- 3. **Only those with a long-term resident status in Australia** can apply for a visa. E.g. Permanent Resident, Work, Student etc.

One copy of documents no. 5, no. 6, and no. 8 per person (children also require their own copy)

LIST OF THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- 1. A valid passport (MRP/e-passport in compliance with the ICAO standard only)
- 2. A valid Australian visa Visa Entitlement Verification Online (VEVO) or Visa Grant Notice PRINTED OFF
- 3. One completed visa application form Fill in all the lines. If a question is not applicable, please put "N/A".
- **4. One recent passport photograph** (taken within the last 6 months) (Australian standard size passport photo, 4.5cm x 3.5cm)
- 5. A letter stating the reason for applying for the multiple-entry visa

At least one A4 length letter and typed up (not handwritten). Include details of your Japan-related interests, future plans to go to Japan and why you would like to apply for the multiple-entry visa. For families, each person's letter must be different and in their own words (including children although parents can help young children with their letters).

6. Documents to substantiate your financial capability (A+B) OR (A+C):

(Documents must show your full name as per your passport)

- **a.** Bank statement or transaction records (savings) for the last **6 months** up to the day of your application showing sufficient funds for your trips to Japan.
 - Any large amounts of deposits must be verified with extra documents
 - Constant transfers from another account into your savings account (as described in 6a.) will require you to also bring 6 months' worth of that other account's transaction records
 - **For spouses or minors whose names are not on the bank records, proof of relationship (marriage certificate for spouse or birth certificate for children), a copy of their passport and <u>a letter of guarantee</u> are required.**
- **b.** Copy of recent payslips showing your annual income or a letter of employment which shows your annual income.
- **c.** Notice of assessment from the ATO, which shows your annual income.
- **7. The proof of relationship** such as a Marriage certificate or Birth certificate if the applicant applies together with his/her spouse or children. (English translation is necessary if written in another language.)
- **8. Flight schedule shown with either a printed off screenshot of intended flights or flight confirmation**A full flight schedule is required starting from Brisbane or Gold Coast, showing ALL transit destinations before and after Japan and returning to Brisbane or Gold Coast. If you are moving to another state or will not be returning to Australia after your trip, please submit a letter specifying those details.
- 9. A visa for the next country that you will visit after Japan (if applicable)

Please note for students who receive money from parents, your parents must already hold a multiple-entry visa or you must apply together with your parents to use their financial records for your visa application.
