As the State Government has since eased restrictions, all staff members cooperation and return to work to the consulate normally as of July 13th (Monday). However, since introduced on March 31st, measures listed below will still be implemented in the waiting room in order measures to prevent listed below COVID-19 infection.

 - If possible, please wear your own mask upon entering the waiting room of our office.
- The maximum number of people who may enter the waiting room at one time has been increased to six (excluding families).
 Should there be seven or more wishing to enter the waiting room, your

contact details will be taken down and you will be contacted when you may enter.
